

Submission Guidelines for Full Papers

NordMedia 2023 Pre-Conference for Doctoral Students 15 August 2023

- Please keep to a word limit of 7,000–8,000 words (exclusive of abstract and references).
- Include the following elements in the first page:
 - o Your name, affiliation, year of study and contact details.
 - An abstract (about 250 words). It can be the same abstract as included in your original submission.
 - O A couple of rows describing the place of your submitted text within your thesis project as a whole (i.e., is it a theory chapter, a method chapter, an empirical chapter if so, what other empirical data is used in the thesis is it an article as part of a compilation thesis, etc.). This information will make it easier for your commentator to offer appropriate feedback.
- Each paper should follow the standard academic structure that includes an introduction, a description of objective(s) and research question(s), review of previous academic literature, a data and method section, analysis and results (preliminary or expected if not applicable), as well as a conclusion/outlook.
- You can choose the referencing technique of your preference (APA, Chicago, Harvard) and use it consistently throughout your paper. APA has an <u>extensive list of reference</u> examples online.
- Remember to add page numbers to the document.
- Be prepared to give a brief oral presentation of your paper (maximum 5 minutes) and to oppose another participant's paper. A detailed schedule as well as more information about the format of the oral presentation and discussion will follow upon submission of full papers.
- Please send your final paper as one pdf to kristin.clay@nordicom.gu.se no later than 3
 July 2023.
